- 0655 ARABIC HAMZA BELOW

Other combining characters (U+0656 – U+065e) are not discussed in this document which may introduce yet another confused characters.

 Since Heh Goal With Yeh Above is equivalent to Heh Goal (U+06C1)+Hamza Above, this simplifies to "Heh <> Heh Goal", which is a Style match in Arabic and Persian, but it's OK in Urdu.

 This simplifies to "Heh Doachashmee <> Ae", which is again a transitive case with normal Heh, as Heh Doachashmee and Ae don't look similar at all to South Asian or Central Asian users.

Comments:
 This simplifies to "Heh Doachashmee <> Heh Goal", which is again a transitive case with normal Heh. They may be considered Style matches for Persian, but again, since none of them appear in Persian, ...
